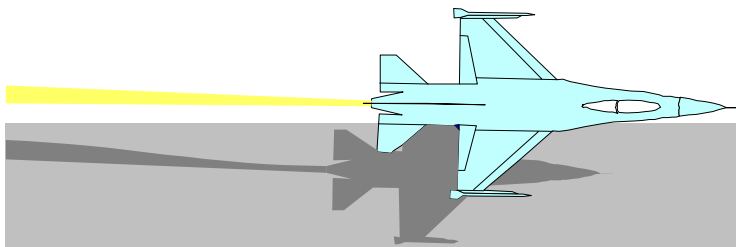

Greetings all. If you missed the February meeting you missed a great presentation by Keith on lipo. I know he answered in his presentation a lot of questions I had on lipos. Once again a big thank you to Keith for giving of his time to enlighten us on the subject of lipos. AMA Grant program. The LMAC board met February 21 to hash around what needs to be done to the runway. We had two proposals from two companies. After much decision we the board decided to submit a grant request to AMA for \$1,300. This is 10% of the project cost. The request is for Adding 50 feet to the right end at \$6,000 and to resurface the right 200 feet of the runway for \$7,000. This was the decision of the Board; this decision was made in order to send the AMA Grant forms to AMA by the end of February. With that said it does not mean that we are going out to do that next week, the decision was only made for the AMA Grant program. I would love to say that we would resurface the full runway but unless someone writes a check out to the club for \$10,000 to \$12,000, we will have to work with what we got. I will talk about this issue more at the March meeting. I look to bring a proposal to the Club by the April meeting for the club to vote on. There is no program on the books for March meeting. - Charles has contacted surrounding clubs to invite them to participate in group picnics. Most have shown interest and Charles will coordinate with them to set dates.

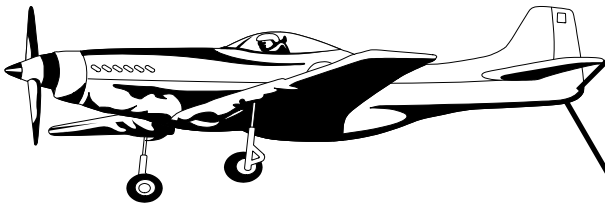
New Business:

LMAC RC FLIGHT TRAINING

The Lexington Model Airplane Club maintains a flight-training program for club members. You must be a member of LMAC to go through the training program. Flight training starts in the spring with the time change and runs through the fall time change. Please contact an instructor to setup a time for training.

The training program starts out with an orientation about our field. We will train you on proper field entry, frequency control, courtesy, and safe operations of our flying site. You will be informed on how to do a preflight inspection of your plane and basic engine operations. We recommend at least 1 hour of flying on the flight simulator before flying a new airplane. The instructor will test fly you plane for the first time before the flight training starts. Basic flight training includes straight & level flight, left right turning boxes, reverse figure eight's, climb & descent, approach, go around, take off and landing. After you have solo flight you are off to the wild blue wonder.
