Minutes of March 14, 2019 Meeting

The monthly meeting of the Lexington Model Airplane Club (LMAC) was called to order on March 14, 2019 by club president Mickey Breunig at 7:04 p.m. The minutes of the February meeting were approved.

Carroll Ware gave a brief treasurer's report and stated we now have 77 paid members.

Thurmon Haga from West Virginia joined the club just before the meeting.

Old Business: discussed the display of planes at the Legacy Center which takes place from 1 - 3 p.m. on March 30th. Setup of the planes starts at 12 p.m. 10 planes are needed for display to be viewed by residents of the Legacy Center.

Concerning the retrieval of planes from the landfill: We are accepting names of volunteers to be trained in the retrieval of planes from the landfill. The board will vote on the final decision.

Curtis Adams continues to research runway improvements.

Paul Bail recommended keeping the same port-a-potty we currently have at the field, and keeping the same rental agreement we had last year with Bypass Rental.

Keith Sessions, chief financial officer of the Academy of Model Aeronautics, gave a lecture at the Bluegrass Aviation Museum Tuesday evening, several LMAC members were present. He discussed the changes under consideration for a federal regulation affecting the flight of model aircraft and drones. Topics/issues discussed:

- Section 336, the Special Rule for Model Aircraft.
- 400 foot altitude limit.
- discussed the AMA's meager financial resources compared to companies like Amazon.
- STEM education.
- Leader/members.

Dan Thompson's LT-40 can transmit altitude data from his plane to his transmitter. Dan has offered to fly his LT-40 at 400 feet over the LMAC airfield so we can have an idea of what an airplane at 400 feet looks like.

The meeting adjourned at 7:58 p.m.

The Club members were: Barnie Davis, George Kissick, Paul Bail, Dan Thompson, Mickey Breunig, John Royalty and Jeff Cummings.


Several residents came by and appreciated the efforts of the club.


