Blast from the Past By David J. Price

This series of articles will present advertisements from vintage modeling magazines. The intent is to illustrate technological advances that have taken place in our hobby. For some it will bring back memories, for newcomers it will present a piece of history of radio control model aviation.

Here is an advertisement from the June-July 1964 issue of Radio-Controlled Modeler for the Aristo Mini-servo from Aristo-Craft. The advertisement had no specs for the mini servo, but I did find the instructions in the web (see below). The servo weighed 1 ¾ oz. (49.6 gram) and was 2 ½ inches long. Based on inflation, the \$15.95 servo would cost \$141.35 in 2022. Think about the cost next time you buy a 9-gram servo for \$3.00.



ARISTO-CRAFT MINI-SERVO

The ARISTO-CRAFT MINI SERVO is a single channel rudder servo powered by the new low drain efficient Aristo Rev #6 motor and is self-neutral-izing.

The small physical size of the MINI SERVO permits a unique installation that couples aileron and rudder for smoother flight maneuvers. Conventional fuselage installation of the MINI-SERVO is very simple because of it's small cross section it can be put in a direct line with the rudder push-rod.

The MINI SERVO provides smooth control surface movement which is a pre-requisite to proper R/C flying. Rudder movements can, however, follow each other in as rapid a rate as may be demanded, with complete control of the model at all times.

TECHNICAL DATA

WEIGHT:..... 3/4 oz.

OPERATING VOLTAGE:3-4.5 Volts

CONTROL SEQUENCE

1 pulse - right (or left rudder) 2 pulse - left (or right rudder)

3rd Short pulse - (triggers an escapement for engine throttle control).
