Here is an advertisement from the December 1930 issue of Junior Mechanics & Model Airplane News (Vol. III, No. 6) for the scale model of the DO-X from A.A.C. Model Aircrafters. Not a flying model, but built from balsa, Japanese tissue, and dope. Based on inflation, today the model would cost \$61.64. According to Wikipedia, “the Dornier Do X was the largest, heaviest, and most powerful flying boat in the world when it was produced by the Dornier Company of Germany in 1929”. Hope Santa brings you lots of RC goodies – Merry Christmas!
