Here is an advertisement from the December 1931 issue of Model Airplane News for the Free Flight 18" R.O.G. Tractor and 20" Verville models from the Ames-Harrell Model Aeronautical Company. The Tractor kit was 50¢ and the Verville was 89¢.

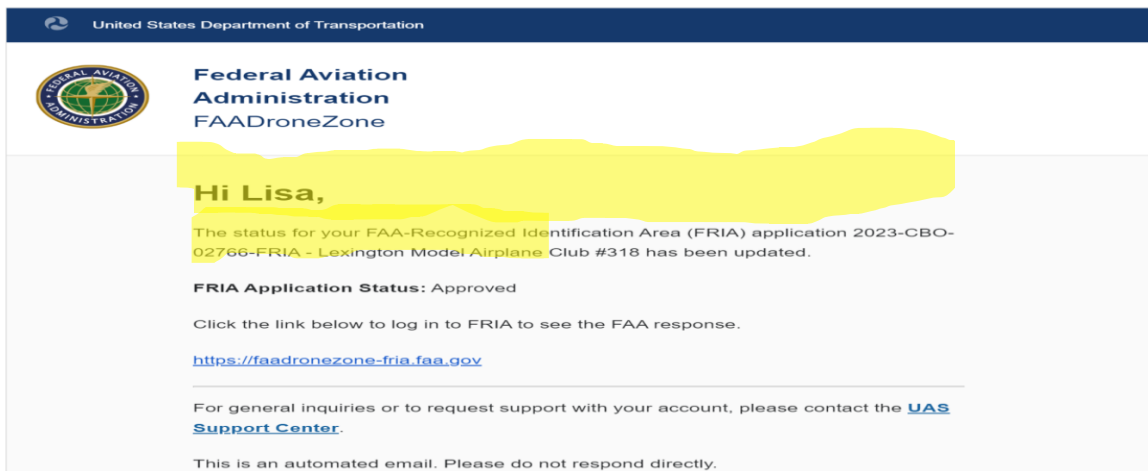


LMAC is now a FRIA Site!!

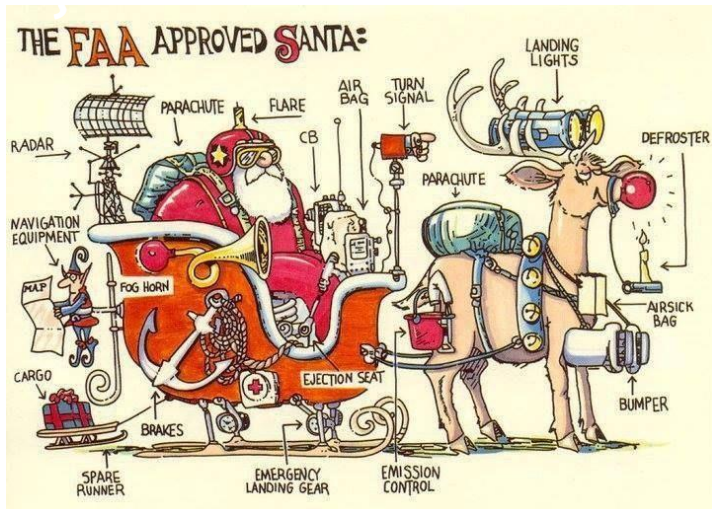
With this approval making our field a FRIA site, this means that if you are flying at the LMAC flying facility you DO NOT have to have a Remote ID Module.

Take a Minute and Brighten Someones Day!

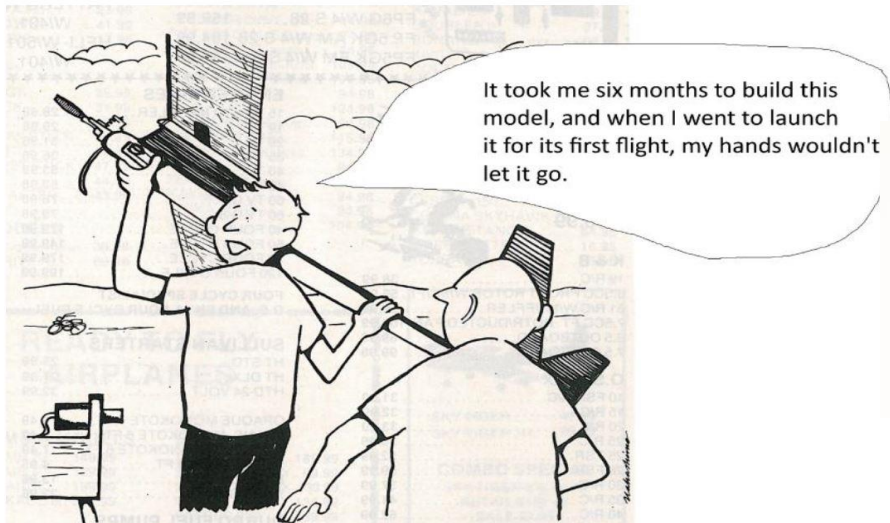
