Blast from the Past By David J. Price

This series of articles will present advertisements from vintage modeling magazines. The intent is to illustrate technological advances that have taken place in our hobby. For some it will bring back memories, for newcomers it will present a piece of history of radio control model aviation.

Here is an advertisement from the February 1955 issue of Model Airplane News for the Cessna 180 from Sterling Models. The Cessna was "Completely Prefabbed", in other words, the kit had die-cut plywood and balsa parts. A lot of kits back then only had the parts ink-stamped on the wood and you had to cut out each part (no laser-cuts back then). The Cessna 180 was for Class ½ A and A engines. Class ½ A refers to methanol-fueled glow engines of .010 to .049 cu. in. displacements, whereas Class A refers to 0.051 - 0.1525 cu. in. displacements.





Finally completed my Eaglet 250, after 3 years of building (See picture). It is electric with a dummy 0.020 engine, covered with Ultracote.


