

Happy New Year! Here is an advertisement from the January 1931 issue of Model Airplane News for the National Models from the National Model Aircraft and Supply Company, New Rochelle, NY. Featuring the Stinson Junior, Boing P-12, Heath Parasol, and Lockheed Sirius (Lindy's favorite ship). I know, they're not RC – but 2 foot flying rubber models are still impressive. Based on inflation, \$3 plane would cost \$49 in 2022.





RC Airplane Definitions

Prop Nut: What a glider pilot calls power pilots.


