Blast from the Past By David J. Price

This series of articles will present advertisements from vintage modeling magazines. The intent is to illustrate technological advances that have taken place in our hobby. For some it will bring back memories, for newcomers it will present a piece of history of radio control model aviation.

Here is an advertisement from the July 1950 issue of Model Airplane News for the OK .049 Cub Power Kit from the Herkimer Tool & Model Works, Inc. You could assemble the engine yourself and save \$1.20. Although 75 cents for a pint of "OK" Glow Fuel sounds inexpensive, it is \$6.00 per gallon in 1950.

Was curious about the Herkimer company, to my surprise they are still open as the Herkimer Tool & Machining Corp. According to their web site: "Herkimer Tool & Machining Corporation was established in 1921. In the beginning, Herkimer was engaged in sub-contract machining work specializing in the production of bearings for the transportation industry. In 1929 the "OK Model Airplane Engine" was designed and developed. After the depression this engine was put into production. Today this high quality model engine remains very popular, especially among collectors. During World War II, Herkimer Tool & Model Works produced thousands of small gasoline engines for our Armed Forces. These engines were installed on drone aircraft for decoy and target applications. After the war, Herkimer returned to subcontract machining and production of the model airplane engines ended for a while in 1965. In 1973, Ellis Green purchased the business and changed the name to Herkimer Tool and Machining Corp. and reinstated production of the HO 1/87th Scale model railroad cars under the "OK" trade name. Herkimer produced these fine quality model railroad passenger cars until the division was sold in 1997 back to the grandson of the founder who also resumed production of some of the gas engines. 




Club Picnic July 30 at LMAC Flying Field
