Safety Report

- A. Starting Safety
 - 1. Be aware of your surroundings
 - 2. Check engine mount and prop for loose engine or broken or damaged prop.
 - 3. Make sure there is nothing that can get sucked into the prop
 - 4. Who is around, are they in line with the prop or in front of it.
 - 5. If you have a neck strap, put it inside your shirt or behind your head.
 - 6. Don't wear loose clothing.
 - 7. Don't allow others to distract you. Politely ask them to move away while you are busy trying to start your plane
 - 8. Are prop tips painted? If not, they should be.
 - 9. Stay out of the danger zone if you are starting the engine. When you are starting the engine, position yourself outside the danger zone when the engine is running.

 3. David...from my review, I do not see anything in the agreement that places any responsibility on LFUCG to cover the property of the LMAC. Additionally, the LFUCG SI policy.....property of others is only covered IF LFUCG is legally liable for it or under an obligation to insure. I do not see anything in the agreement regarding indemnity for their property, unless it was due to a negligent act of LFUCG.
 4. Note from David Price

I was in contact with Mike Skidmore, Manager – Risk, Safety and Loss Control Mgt., Human Resources and Harold Mattingly, Claims Manager, Department of Law regarding the damage to LMAC property due to the storm. I have attached the email string I have from LFUCG. From their emails, it appears that we will have to pay for the repairs. Mickey may have a new angle to approach the City.
6. Wind Damage





In 1975, the Thunderhead 0.074 engine cost \$7.95. I just got an email from www.mikegoesflying.com where they sell a SH .07 R/C Glow Engine with Tuned Exhaust for \$99.99 + S&H.
