The club meeting was held on Saturday, May 13th, 2017 at LMAC Airfield, 4200 Hedger Lane, Lexington, KY.

Dan Thompson, Vice President, called the meeting to order at 11:00AM. Mickey Breunig, President, was unable to attend the meeting.

Minutes of the last meeting were provided in the newsletter. Motion was made by Curtis Adams to approve the minutes, seconded by Gayle Moore and approved by membership vote.

Treasurer's Report was presented by Carroll Ware. Currently, there are 106 members who have paid dues. There is \$12,993. in the checking account and \$621.63 in the education account. The airfield maintenance account has \$3,750.00 set aside to cover future planned major airfield expenses. Motion was made by Mike Lambert to approve the report, seconded by PJ Ash and approved by membership vote.

1. Saturday Club Meetings
