Blast from the Past By David J. Price

This series of articles will present advertisements from vintage modeling magazines. The intent is to illustrate technological advances that have taken place in our hobby. For some it will bring back memories, for newcomers it will present a piece of history of radio control model aviation.


Here is an advertisement from the April 1936 issue of Model Aircraft Builder for the Selley-Tex "moulded" kits. The advertisement claimed that "To everyone who ever FAILED to build an All-Balsa-Stick Kit" Selley offered a full money back guarantee. A sort-of ARF in 1936, the fuselage and other parts are pre molded fabric that you joined and glued (fiberglass? — I could not find what the composition was). Similar to the construction of fiberglass pattern airplanes and ducted fan jets and you still had to build the wings. There was the article about "Developments in the Model Industry" later in the same magazine issue that cited the new construction technique.

HAT is considered the outstanding development in model airplane kit manufacture has been credited to the Selley Manufacturing Company for the perfection of the Selley-Tex Molded Construction employed in their new kits.

The fuselage sides, cowlings, pants, dummy motor, fairings, bombs and other details are beautifully formed, bearing out the most minute details, in fact all those parts which are considered by many model builders as difficult to make, are ready formed, making the building of these models simplicity itself.


Armour Selley, President of the Selley Manufacturing Company is a

model builder of the old school, in fact, in 1912 Mr. Selley held every world's model plane record. An editorial in "Aircraft" the leading aeronautical magazine at the time called him the champion model flyer of the world. The boy who in 1912 broke every existing flying record is now president of his own company with one of the world's largest manufacturing plants. Many developments now accepted as commonplace are credited to the ingenious Mr. Selley. It was he who in 1912 was the first to use a slow turning propeller. Up to that time only small high speed propellers had been used in contest models.

The present line of Selley-Tex models consists of: Rearwin Sport, Monocoupe, Vought Corsair "Junior", Bellanca "Swoop", Curtiss "Osprey", ranging in price from 75c to \$1.25 and a line of larger models of the Ryan Sportster, Fairchild, Waco "C", Goshawk, Waco "D" Military and Boeing F4B4 ranging in price from \$3.00 to \$4.00.


