Here is an advertisement from the June-July 1964 issue of RCM for four Aero Model airplanes. They are single channel, for 0.010 to 0.19 sized engines. There was also a review article in the same magazine issue (see below). Even today, the swept back wing design makes these airplanes look modern. May be good candidates for modern miniature RC equipment.

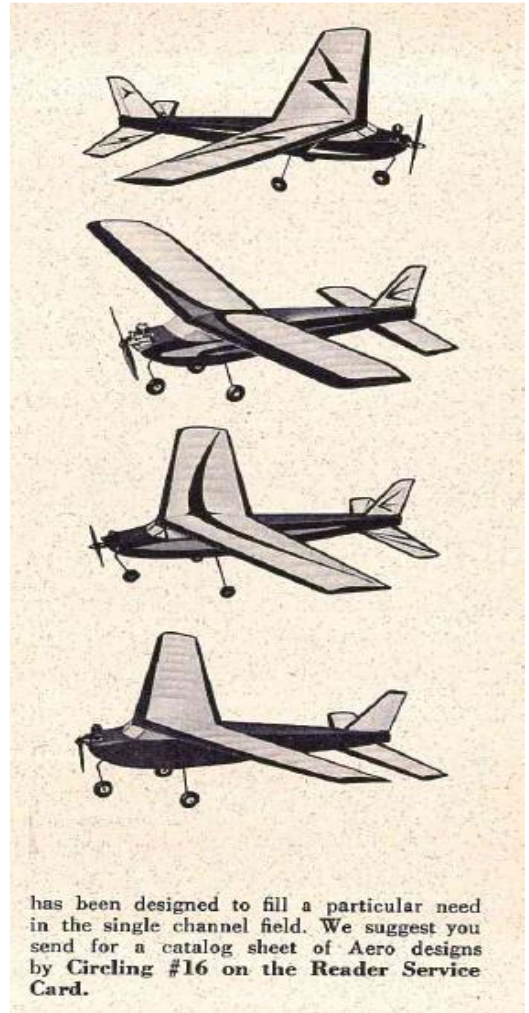
