- G. Second by Dave Price time 11:46am

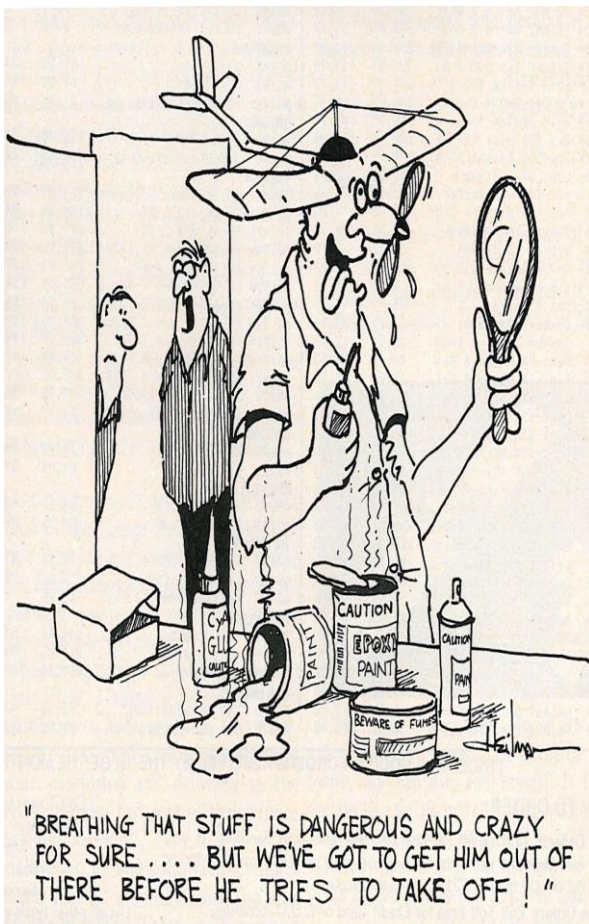


Blast from the Past

This series of articles will present advertisements from vintage modeling magazines. The intent is to illustrate technological advances that have taken place in our hobby. For some it will bring back memories, for newcomers it will present a piece of history of radio control model aviation.

Here is an advertisement from the February 1955 issue of Model Airplane News for Aero Gloss Dope in Spray can form from Pactra Chemical Company. Many, many, many years ago when I used Silk and Dope for covering U-control airplanes, Aero Gloss was one of dope brand I used (Sig Dope, K&B Hobbypoxy, and Pactra Formula-U were other brands used). Never used the spray can, it was always brushed-on. Due to the fumes, it had to be a very well ventilated area.

LMAC Members;

The LMAC Swap Meet is rapidly approaching. Things are taking shape, but due to my current physical limitations I am requesting your help.

Our 2022 LMAC Swap Meet (AMA Sanction Event Number: 13667) is on November 12, 2022, 9AM to 1PM. The meet will be held in the West Jessamine High School, 2101 Wilmore Rd., Nicholasville, KY 40356. That is on Hwy 29 between US 27 Bypass and US 68. Same location as in 2021.

Table reservations are coming in. The tables are first come, first served, so make sure to reserve your table(s) soon. Tables are \$12 in advance, \$15 day of meet, additional tables \$10 each. Free admission with table purchase. To reserve tables contact: David Price (859) 263-1330.

The setup of the tables for our Swap Meet will be handled by a group of Students at the school on Friday afternoon. So, we will not need to do that early morning setup as in the past.

There are 14 steps to get into the facility and a Handicap walkway to avoid the steps. The distance from the parking lot to the cafeteria is longer than we had at the prior facility. Therefore, we need LMAC members to help the Sellers get to their tables and after the event to help the Sellers back to their vehicles. It would be great to have a good turnout of members to help out both **before** and, especially, **AFTER** the swap meet. The Sellers should arrive for setup between 8 AM and 9 AM; but experience says they will be there starting at 7:00-7:30 AM. So, if you can, arrive at 7:30 AM. The event will be over at 1:00 PM promptly. Volunteers will have their Admission cost refunded.

Mickey has obtained a food truck for the event. I have sent a mass email to 236 nearby clubs and the ad will be in the November AMA magazine.

Please contact me if you can help. I am getting a list of volunteers ready. Together we can make this event a success for the LMAC.

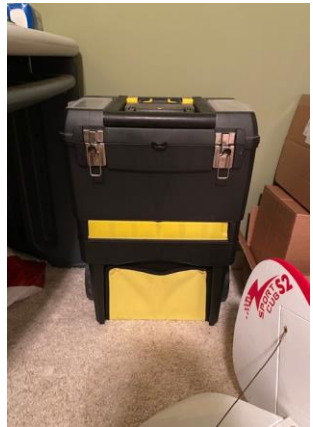
