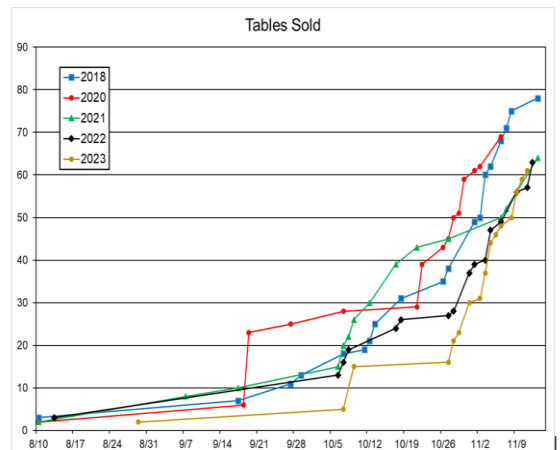

Here is an advertisement from the February 1955 issue of Model Airplane News for Jim Walker's "Fire Bee" U-control with Remote Control throttle. According to the article: "The finger-operated throttle control on U-control handle actuates 'power and silencer control' on the engine".
