Model of the Month

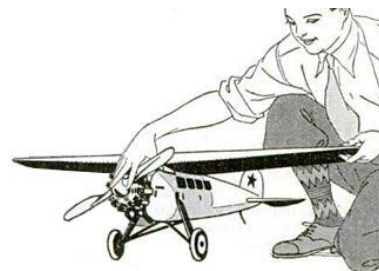

This 14-1/2 pound model has a 48 inch wing span and is an old glow powered fan jet that Sylvester converted to an electric fan jet using a Dynamax Fan power plant with 12 cell LiPo batteries. Flying time with this propulsion system is about 3 minutes. To finish off this model, Sylvester used the PPG Base Coat, Clear Coat paint system to create a beautifully designed paint job. Nice job, Sylvester !!

Blast from the Past

This series of articles will present advertisements from vintage modeling magazines. The intent is to illustrate technological advances that have taken place in our hobby. For some, it will bring back memories, for newcomers it will present a piece of history of radio control model aviation.

Here is an advertisement for the Mattel Radio from the March 1976 issue of Radio Control Modeler (RCM). This was my first radio, which I installed in a Falcon Jr. and flew briefly before gravity took over. The system was a single-channel, pulse radio on 27 MHz (rudder only). The TX took 6 C-cell batteries and the receiver used 2 AA batteries. The rudder pulsed back and forth and when you gave it left or right it would be full deflection to the left or right.

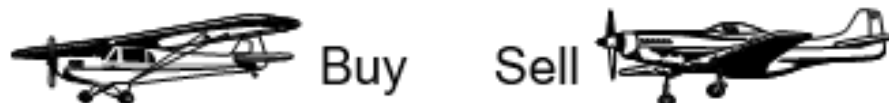
The 2016 KY Fall Classic Fly-in was another successful event, thanks to Curtis Adams, Mickey Breunig and their special event team.

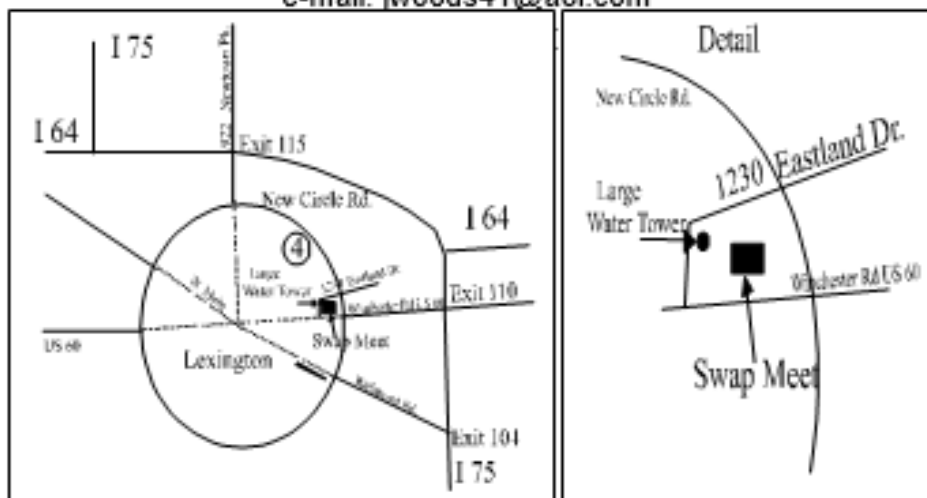
