Here is an advertisement from the October 1951 issue of Model Airplane News for Mel Anderson Manufacturing Company's "Spitzzy" Nitromic "Balance Power" Glow Fuel. There was a \$500 reward for any glow fuel formula that will out-perform "Spitzzy" Nitromic Fuel. I wonder if the reward was ever was claimed? The fuel cost \$6.80 per gallon, which would cost \$71.55 in 2021 based on the rate of inflation.

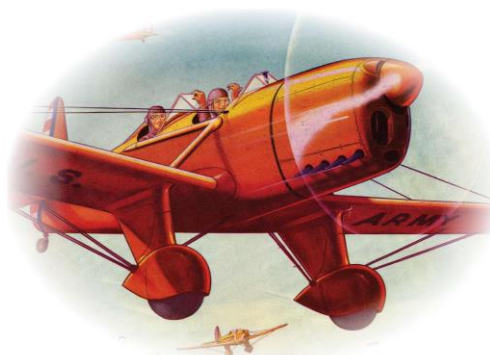
