This series of articles will present advertisements from vintage modeling magazines. The intent is to illustrate technological advances that have taken place in our hobby. For some it will bring back memories, for newcomers it will present a piece of history of radio control model aviation.

Here is an advertisement from the October 1951 issue of Model Airplane News for "Spitzy" Nitromic Glow Fuel Anderson Mel from Manufacturing Co. The advertisement claims was a \$500 reward for any glow fuel formula that would out-perform "Spitzy" Nitromic Glow Fuel. Do not know if the reward was ever claimed. Nitromic Glow Fuel was not cheap, at 0.85 cents per pint or \$6.80 per gallon in 1951.
